Answer: Christ ascended to heaven, there to show that he is the Head of his church, and that the Father rules all things through him.

Q51: How does this glory of Christ our Head benefit us?

Answer: First, through his Holy Spirit he pours out his gifts from heaven upon us his members. Second, by his power he defends us and keeps us safe from all enemies.

³Put not your trust in princes, in a son of man, in whom there is no salvation. ***When his breath departs, he returns to the earth;** on that very day his plans perish.

⁵Blessed is he whose help is the God of Jacob, whose hope is in the LORD his God,
⁶who made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, who keeps faith forever;
⁷who executes justice for the oppressed, who gives food to the hungry.
